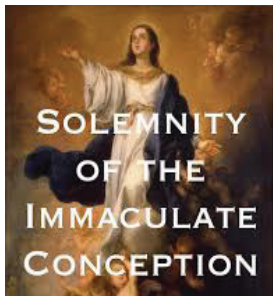


## Weekday Altar Servers and Lectors

## Humanitarian Crisis in Myanmar

In response to the Rohingya situation in Myanmar, the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace (Caritas Canada) is working with Caritas Bangladesh to support a food distribution program along the Bangladesh/Myanmar border. 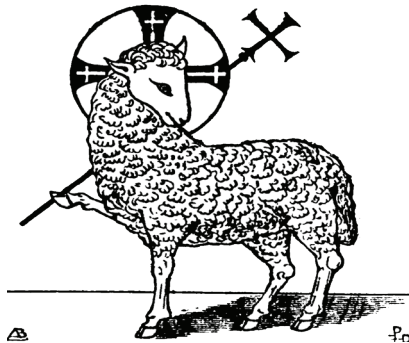
