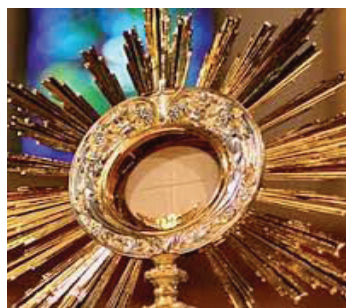
Fish Fry
